and their daughter, Amelia.

It was a hectic thirteen days which included a few days of uncertainty as Amelia, our fourteen month old grandchild ran a fever, and it took days to find out that she had an ear infection! So after sleepless nights, relief came with ear drops and antibiotics.

Alison gave her testimony at a Ladies' Meeting at Bukit Mertajam and gave us all a glimpse of the amazing time ahead she will have in ministry with her husband.

Aaron preached at a Combined Home Cell gathering in Ipoh and bought the presence of God down upon the people present. Catch phrase for that night – "You Pray and you obey!"

In Bukit Mertajam, he spoke to an English speaking congregation and a Tamil one too.

In Kuala Lumpur we found in one Church, four first born Pastors' sons. All four of them are presently serving the Lord in one way or another.

Don and Angelina have had quite a busy time in Ipoh, Bukit Mertajam and Kuala Lumpur.

God is good, and as we write this report today, we have had to go to the dentist as Don was awake all night with an infected tooth. He is now on antibiotics and pain killers and we are praying that the tooth will be saved. Please pray with us about this.

PRAYER POINTS:

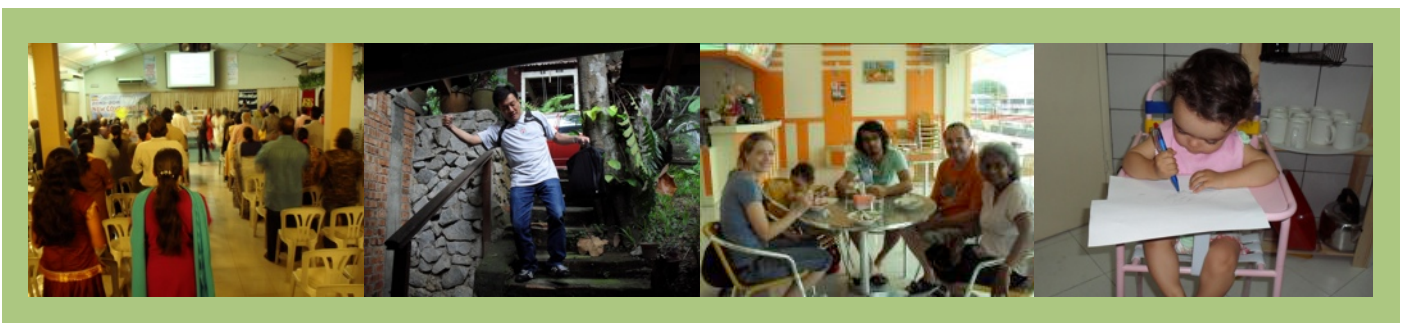
For the Ministry ahead of us in 2010.....

6. Pray for the second 5ONE4 team arriving on 3rd July for 10days please. Micah, Diane and Sue. They have a very heavy schedule.

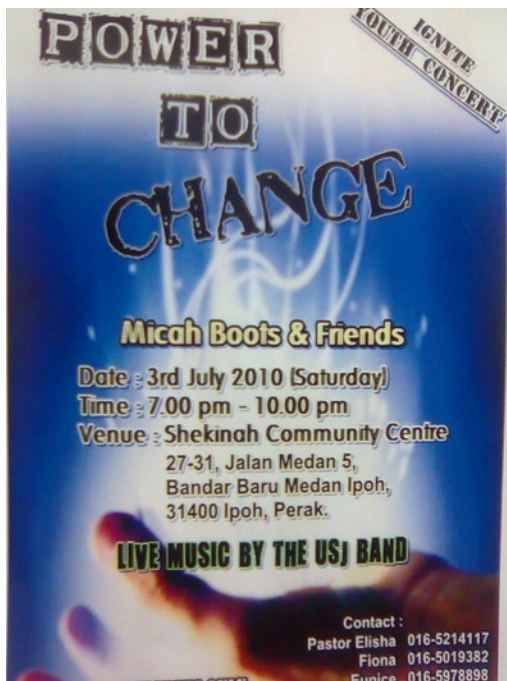
